



Alopecia Areata

Alopecia areata is one of the most common hair loss disorders characterized by loss of hair in small, coin-sized, round patches of baldness on the scalp, although hair elsewhere such as the beard, eyebrows, eyelashes, body and limbs can be affected ,too. It may develop at any age. The exact cause is unknown, but it seems to be caused by the immune system attacking the hair follicles. Recurrence of the condition can be seen.

Dr. Amir will assess the condition and advises suitable treatment regimen to each one of his patients. This condition can resolve on its own or can be treated with topical or steroid injections.
