



Botox for Hyperhidrosis

Hyperhidrosis, or excessive sweating, is an uncomfortable condition affecting some people with lots of social, personal, and occupation effects.

In some conditions simple treatment of Botox can treat the situation. When Botox is injected near the sweat glands, that signals the glands to stop sweating. It can take a few days or more for the procedure to work but the results are dramatic. Consequently, there is decrease of sweat production in that area that lasts several months. Remarkably, up to a third of our patients can go 1 year before they return for more. Therefore, you are treated once or maximally twice per year and don't have to worry about constantly treating the area. It can also be used over other body areas such as forehead, feet and hands.

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
